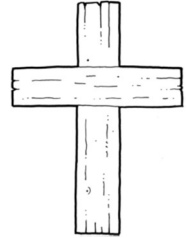

### Reflection

We are all God's children through faith in Christ. Our faith is given to us by God, and through his gracious love and mercy we are all one. We are all equal. It does not matter what your family ancestry is, where you come from, whether you have employment or not, whether you have money or not, whether you are strong or weak, whether you are male or female, or whether you are an adult or a child. The Lord's Prayer – Introduction

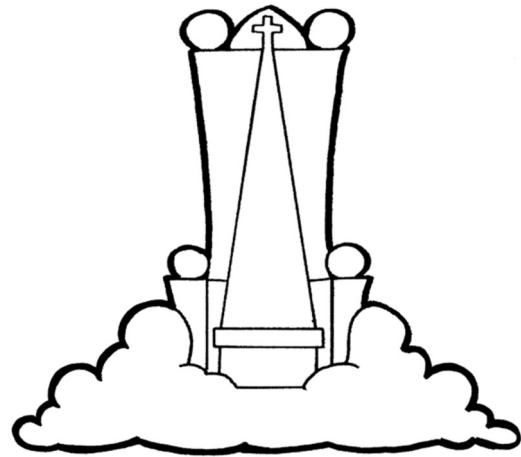
Our Father in Heaven.
